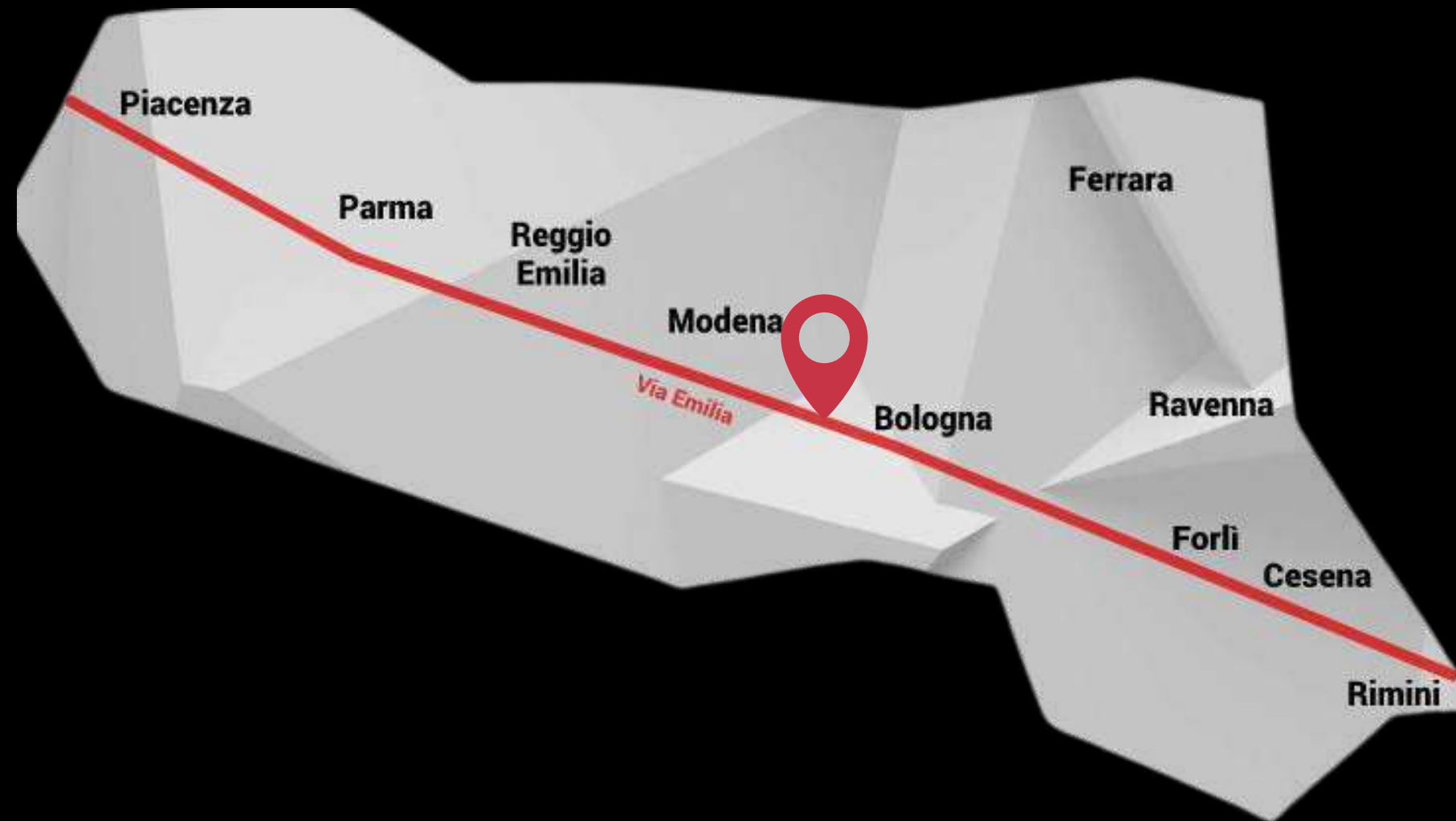

WHAT IS THE *“Motor Valley”*



Modena is the birthplace of Enzo Ferrari, and automobile manufacturing and legends of speed are an integral part of local culture. A talent for business, a passion for high-performance machines, a devotion to the possibilities of mythical speed—those ingredients have made Modena the car capital of Italy and the world, in the heart of the

Motor Valley. In addition to the Ferrari Museums, a journey of only a few kilometers takes visitors to plants, private collections and to such shrines as the Maserati plant and showroom, the Umberto Panini Collection of vintage cars, the Stanguellini Museum, the Righini Collection, the Pagani factory and its museum, and the Autodromo di Modena. A few kilometers from Modena you will find the museums and factories of Lamborghini and Ducati in Bologna, Dallara in Parma... and many other attractions!



DAY 1: *Milano to Bologna*

FIRST ENCOUNTER WITH THE MOTORVALLEY



On the first day you'll reach "Bologna", the capital city of the Emilia-Romagna Region. During your stay a motor valley specialist will guide you through the visit of Ducati Motorcycle factory. The "two-wheels" made in "Borgo Panigale" represent the excellence in this industry. You'll be guided through the production lines, the Ducati Museum, the history and the future of this important brand. After the check-out you'll reach Modena, the world famous capital city of fast cars. On the first day you'll visit the Maserati Factory. A world leader in the production of luxury sports cars, Maserati's unmistakably stylish, high-performance automobiles are always a standout. Unique, elegant, and sporty, "The Trident's" models are unlike any other. Visit the Maserati showroom and book a factory tour your for an in-person experience of these Italian-made masterworks. Few steps... and you'll reach the "Museo Enzo Ferrari", the museum inaugurated in 2021 consists in two buildings: the historical garage and house, where Enzo Ferrari, the founder of the company, was born, and a brand new futuristic structure, designed by Jan Kaplický. Lunch in a bistrot in the city center to taste the local food products (Balsamic Vinegar, Parmigiano Cheese, Lambrusco Wine, Modena ham...)

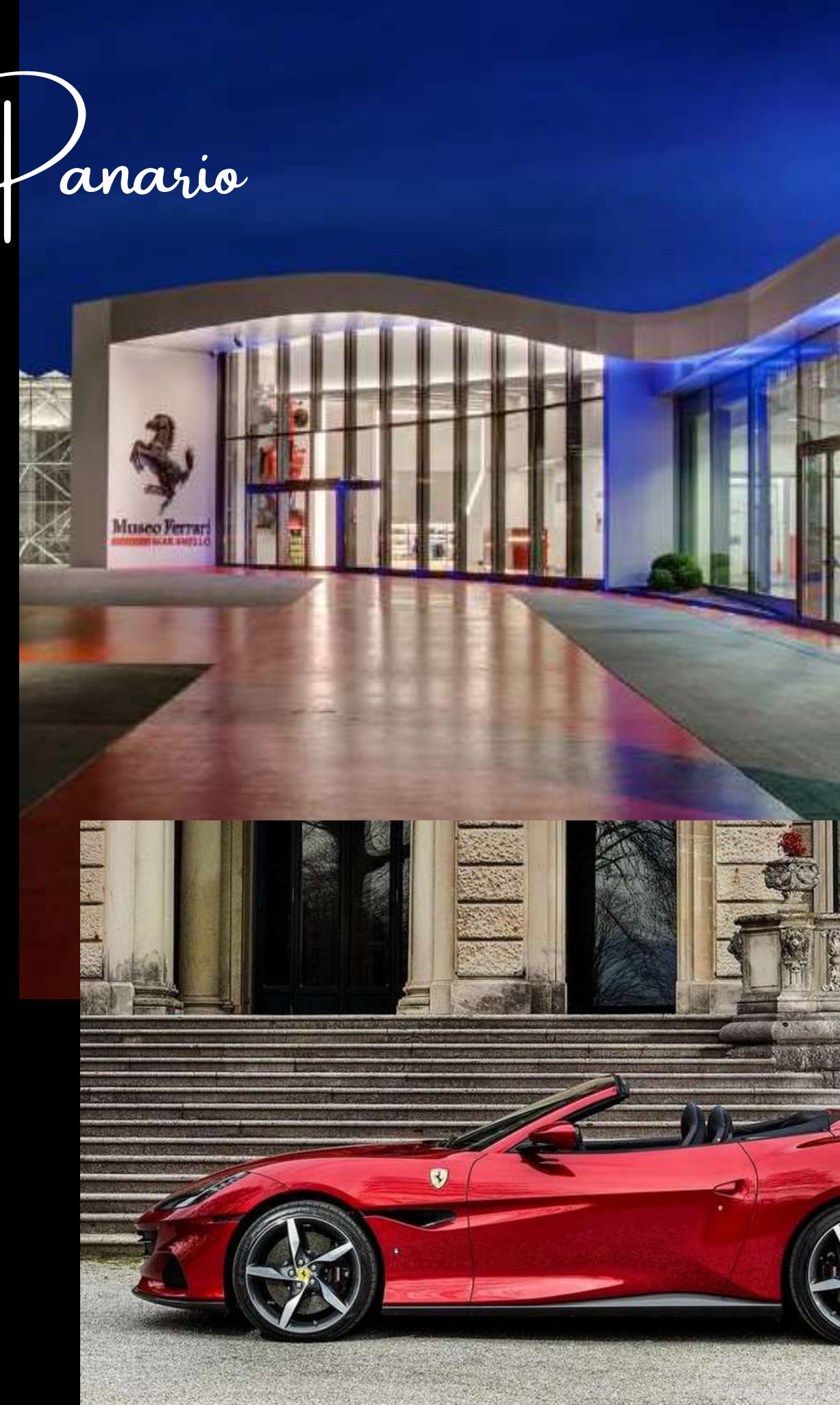


The afternoon will be dedicated to the discovery of an hidden gem: the "Stanguellini" private museum. DAY 4: Maranello & San Cesario Sul Panario

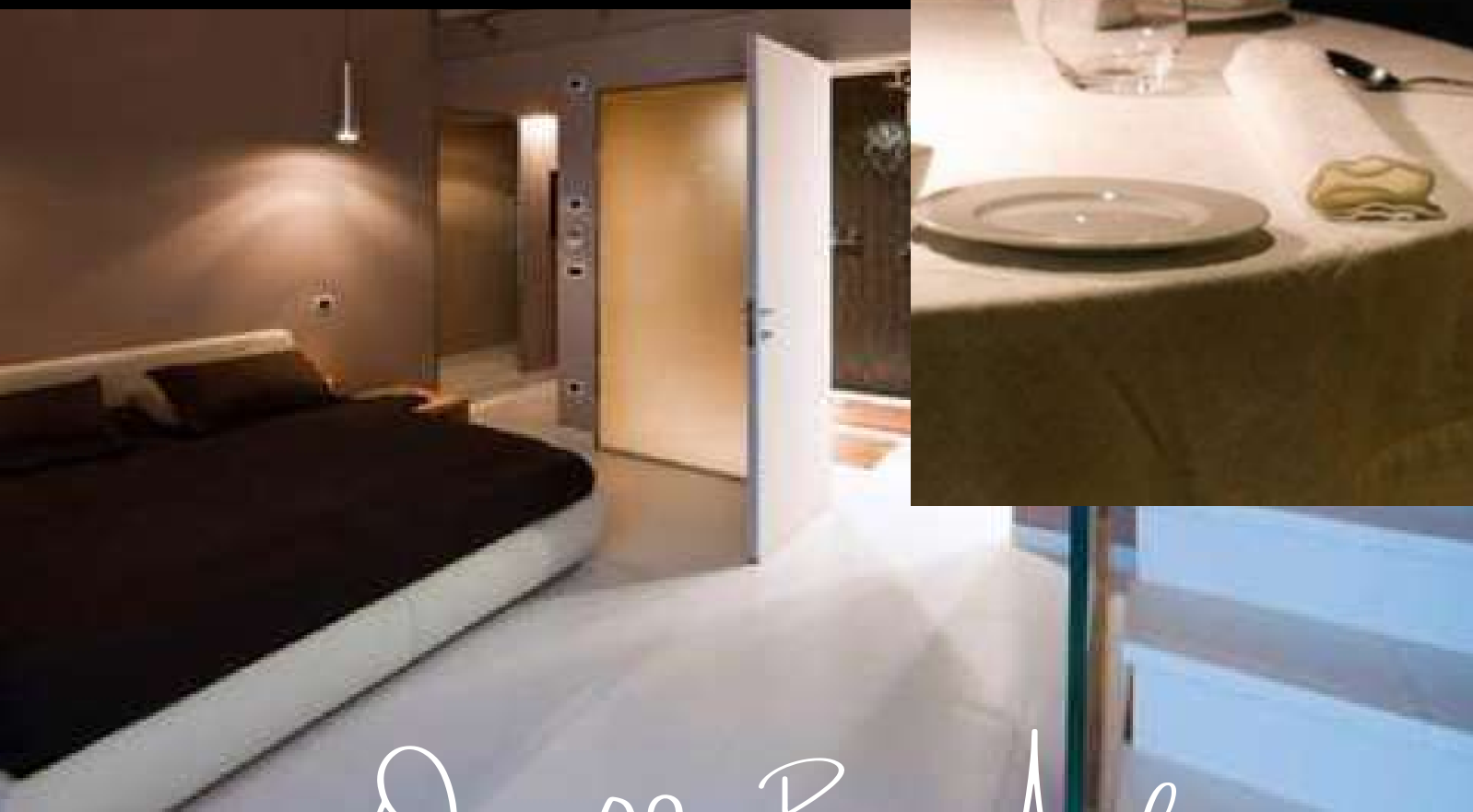
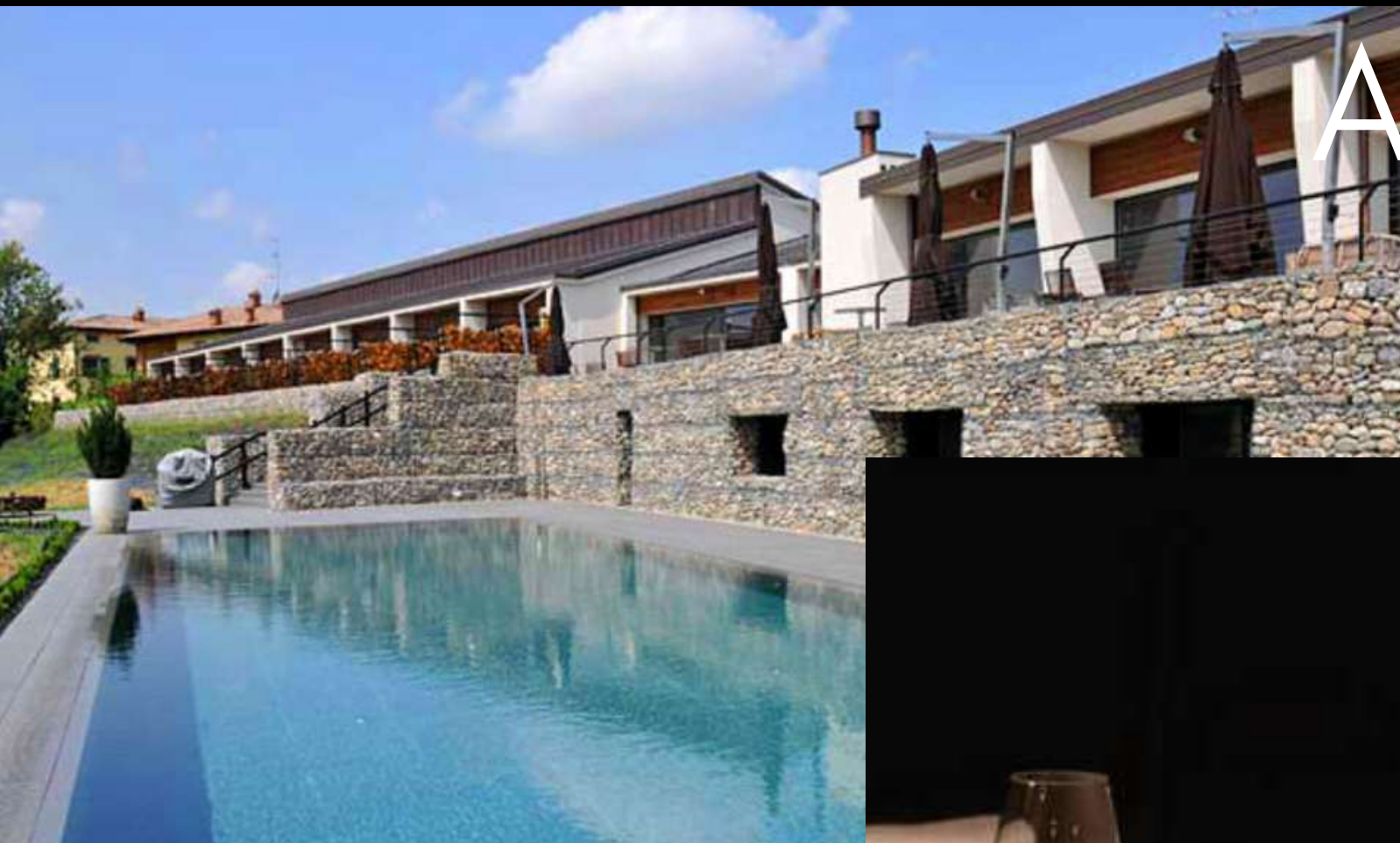
On your 4th day you'll reach the cozy Maranello... best know as the "home" of the prancing horse. The Ferrari factory is just here, in this little village few kilometers from Modena. You'll attend a "VIP" private tour of the Ferrari Museum located few walkspets from the factory. This well-organized museum takes visitors among the most celebrated Formula 1 cars, the legendary models of the SP and Gran Turismo series, and the road cars that have become standard-setters in the industry. Just outside the museum you'll jump on board of a Ferrari Portofino, and you'll drive on the hills around the factory to fully enjoy the roar of the engine, the landscape and the sensations that only the "Made in Maranello" cars can give you! Enjoy the Ferrari univers in Maranello, and see how the most fast (and expansive) cars in the world are made! In the afternoon: guided tour at the Pagani Autobili, in San Cesario sul Panaro. The philosophy driving the company embraces a concept borrowed from the Renaissance and embodied by the great Leonardo da Vinci who, over 500 years ago, once stated: "Art and Science are disciplines that must walk together hand in hand." Pagani Automobili creates in accordance with this inspirational creed, combining technique and taste, functionality and aesthetics, handcraft work and technological know-how.
